Aquai : Care Aquarium

Aquai is a log based app where you take care of fish while taking care of yourself. If you are doing good, your fish are doing good and vice versa. Aquai provides users with their own virtual aquarium where they can unlock aquatic friends as they journal their mood and daily tasks.

Users are given an inventory where they can view their fish and learn a little more about them as well. Users are also able to name their aquarium, change profile pic based on your unlocked fish, and view the stats of the fish. **Aquai** gives users an interface that makes it feel good to keep up with wellness and mental health.

Navigation



Log

The Log button takes users to the log page, where you log your daily tasks and mood. Pressing the “How are you feeling today?” fishies allow you to mark if you are feeling good, okay, and bad for the day which correlates to the overall health of your fish (seen under Stats). Users are able to mark their task completion, scroll to previous days’ tasks, and edit tasks as needed.



Aquarium

The Aquarium button takes users back to the main aquarium screen, where you can watch your fish swim at your leisure. Upon unlocking, different fish appear at random every time you open your aquarium. Clicking on a fish brings the user to their “fin-formation” page.



Fin-ventory

The Fin-ventory button brings users to their fish inventory (Hence, fin-ventory). Here is where you can view all of your fish which are sorted into categories of the different sea life one has unlocked. Unlocking fish is based on task tracking, days logged, and daily streaks.

Fin-formation

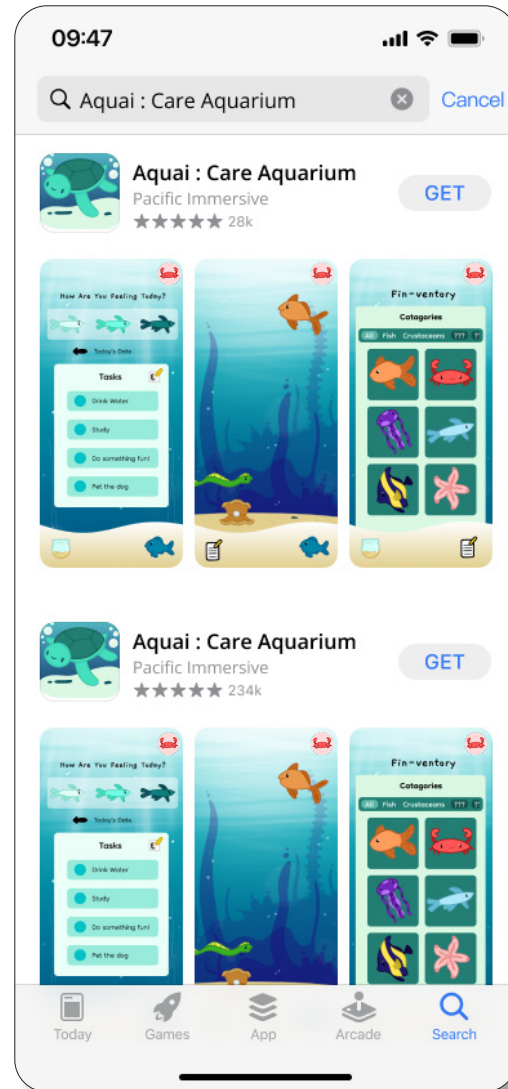
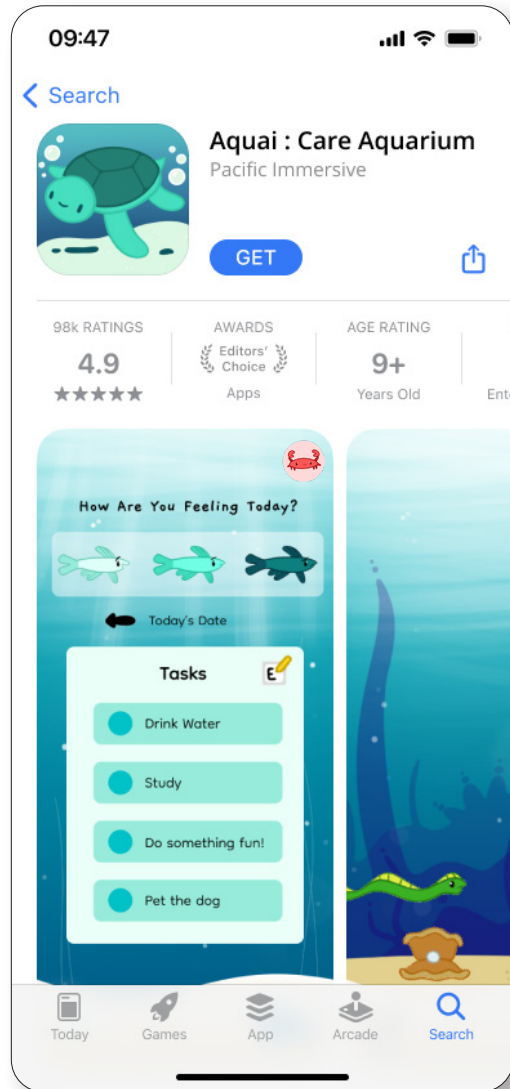
Clicking on a fish in your fin-ventory brings users to that fish’s information (fin-formation) page. This page gives the name of the fish and information



User Profile

The User Profile button brings users to their profile page. Here users can view the health of their fish, percentage of tasks they have completed for the day, and their overall cumulative stats. Users are also able to press the edit button, which allows them to change the name of their aquarium and profile pictures based on the fish they have unlocked so far.

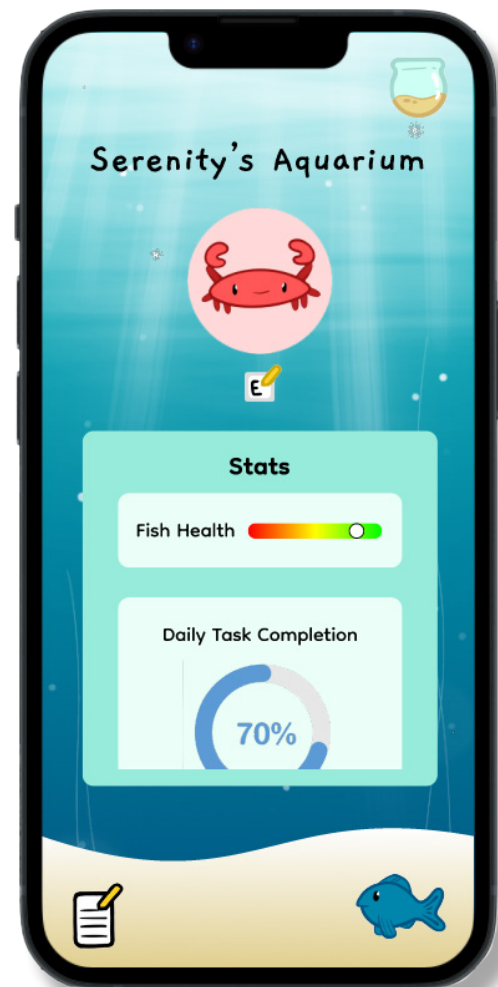
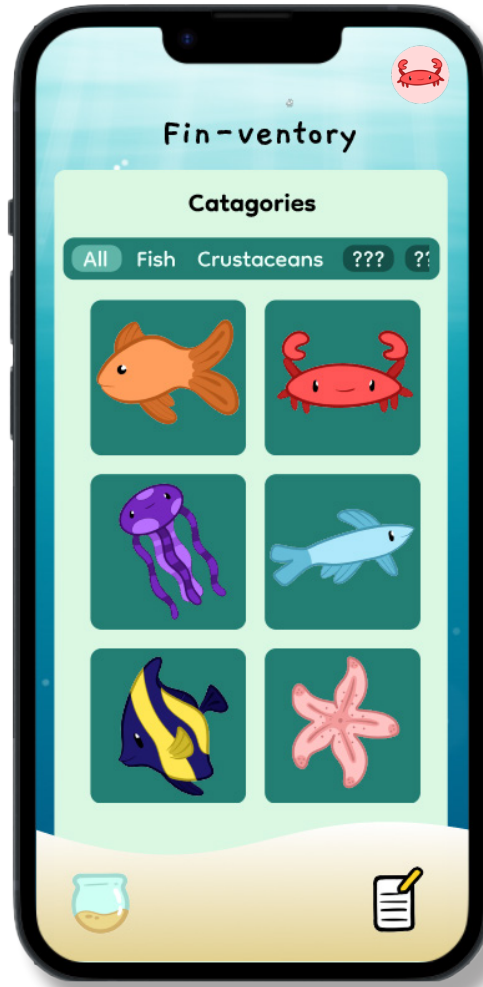
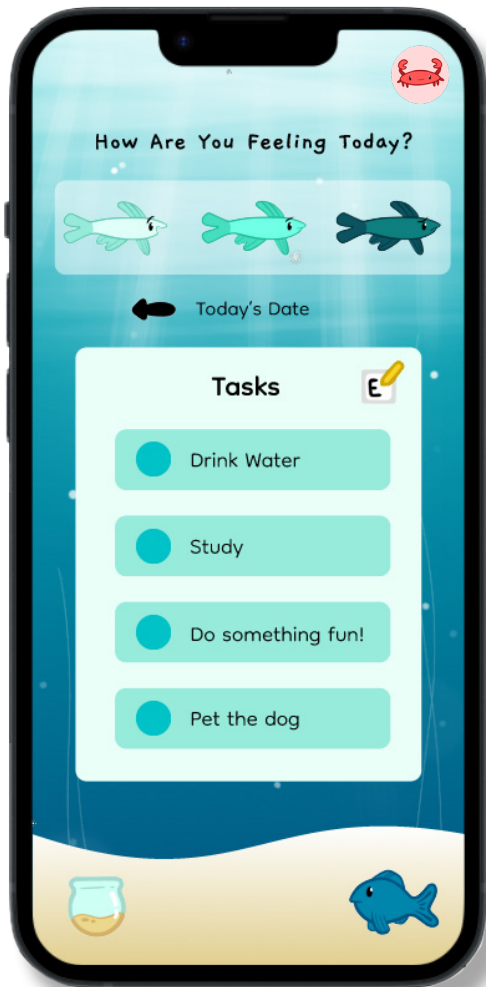
