## Meet Winnie. Age: 11

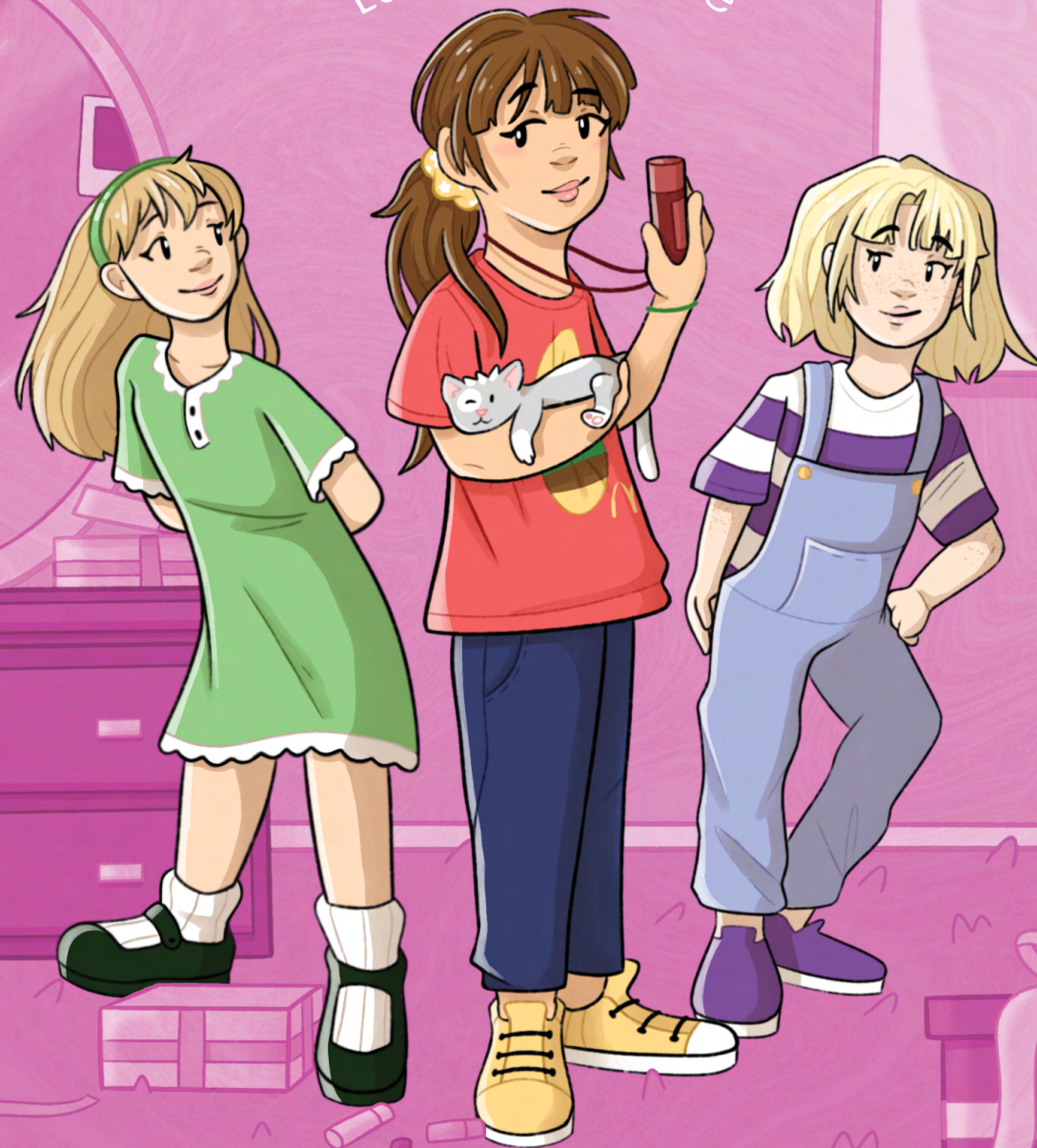

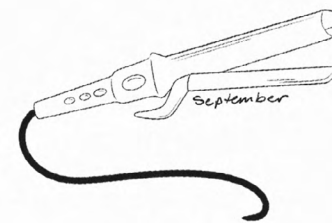
“I know,” I said. The Wilsons’ Honda pulled into our driveway, and I slung my duffel bag over my shoulder. “Bye, Mom! Love you!”

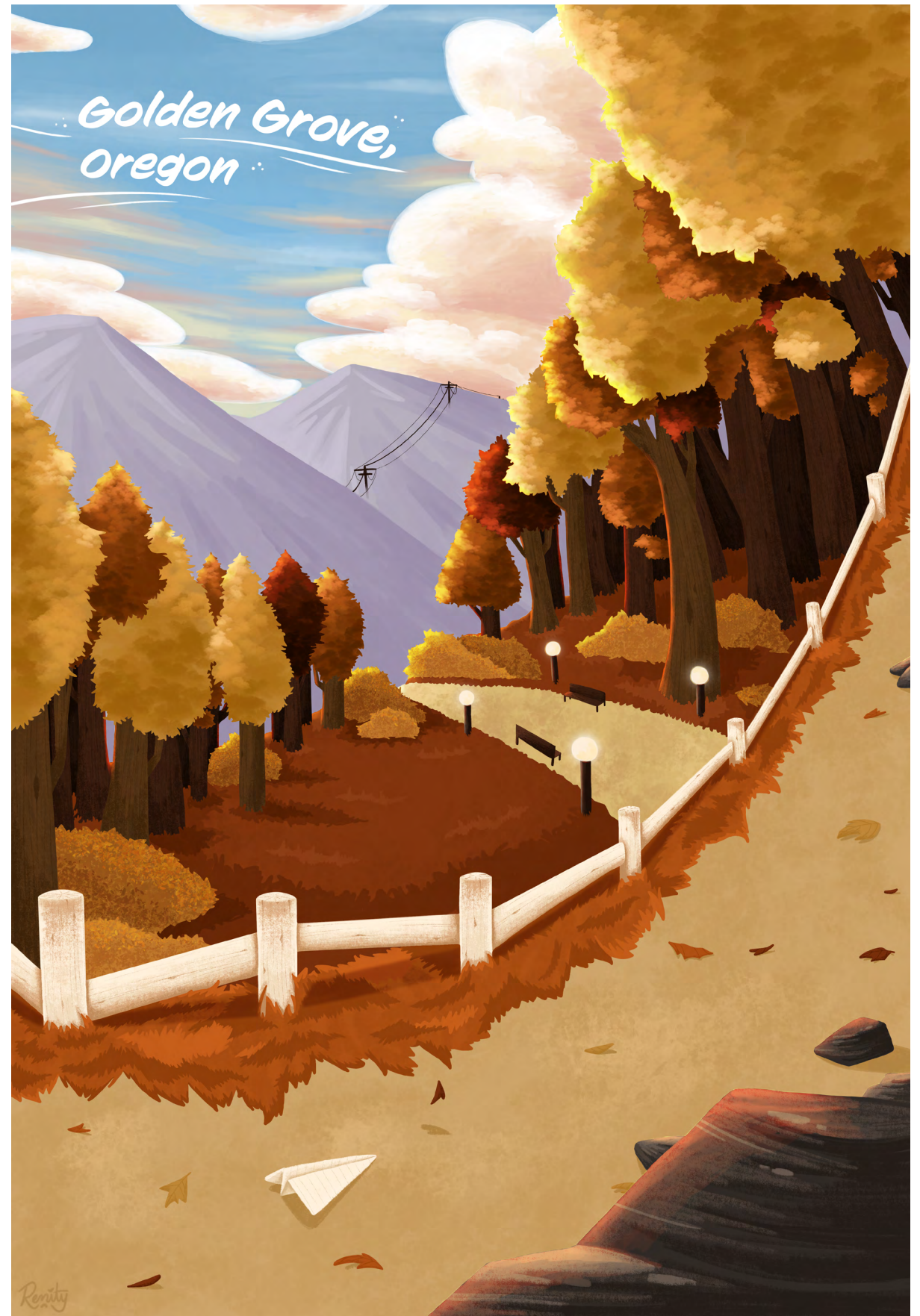
